Regulations Governing the Use of the Basketball

Courts in Block G



1. When using the Basketball Courts in Block G (hereinafter referred to as the

Only colorfast sports shoes are allowed on the Courts. Anyone practicing must wear appropriate sports equipment;

- 2. Behaviors that are prohibited on the Courts:
 - 4.1 Smoking;
 - 4.2 Eating and drinking (except for the consumption of drinking water);
 - 4.3 Pets:
 - 4.4 Bringing beverages in glass bottles;
- 3. Users must take good care of their belongings. The University will not be held responsible in the event of theft or loss;
- 4. Users who have damaged or lost items and equipment provided by the University shall be responsible for paying the appropriate price accordingly. If users in question refuse to pay, the damage will be dealt with differently depending on role of the user: for students, the damage will be deducted from their deposit; for staff, the Human Resources Office will assist in dealing with the damage;
- 5. Users must obtain prior consent from the University before they can move the equipment in the Courts;
- 6. Users must keep the Courts clean after each use, throwing away any rubbish in the



bins and taking away their belongings. Users who fail to keep the Courts clean and free of rubbish should pay for cleaning; otherwise, the University reserves the right to pursue relevant responsibilities;

- 7. Users must use the Courts for the purposes of sport and exercise. Should users engage in activities other than sports and exercise, or engage in any conduct that violates the existing applicable laws and regulations of the Macau SAR Government, and the property of the Courts is damaged, the University reserves the right to pursue relevant responsibilities;
- 8. Rubber flooring has been installed in these Courts to serve only for the purpose of sports and exercise only; therefore, these Courts cannot be used as driving lanes for motor vehicles and trucks. All motor vehicles and trucks are prohibited from entering the Courts; if the Courts are damaged or any injuries or casualties are caused by anyone entering the Courts in contravention of this regulation, the offending party must take full responsibility; in this case, the University will not accept any responsibility but reserves the right to pursue relevant responsibilities;
- 9. Users should have a clear understanding of their physical condition before engaging in the relevant sports, and should take responsibility for any accidents that may occur during the use of the Courts;

- 11. The University reserves the final right to interpret and amend these Regulations.
